

College of Agriculture and Natural Resources Innovation Grant

Application Deadline

The 2021 College of Agriculture and Natural Resources Innovation Grant application will be accepted at between September 23, 2021 and May 31, 2022.

Eligibility to Apply

Faculty and professional staff within the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources are eligible to apply. More than one proposal may be submitted per individual provided that each proposal is distinct.

Proposals for 2021

The intent of the grant is to provide funding for projects and initiatives that may not otherwise be eligible for financial support through the Organized Research Grant, Student Travel Grant, Faculty Development Grant, or other Tarleton programs. As such, the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources Innovation Grant seeks to support creative and new projects/ initiatives that are modest in scope but have potential for long-term impact. Funding will not be provided for on-going projects/research or extensions of current work. All funded projects must be completed by August 31, 2022. Recipients should be prepared to present the outcomes of their work in writing and orally upon completion of the project. To encourage the development of innovative project proposals, submissions should address one or more of the following goals:

- Improving student opportunity and success;
- Enhancing academic distinction through innovative instruction;
- Promoting diversity, equity and inclusion;
- Creating research innovation and economic impact through partnerships; or
- Realizing institutional prominence through student achievement and thriving employee experience.

Proposals that could also generate revenue and become self-sustaining will be viewed favorably.

Application Length

The entire application should be no longer than two pages, single-spaced. There is no page limit for the budget estimate portion of the proposal (it is not included in the 2-page limit). You may want to type your responses in a Word document to determine when you have met the two-page limit and save for copy/pasting into the application form and for future reference.
