Appeals process

A student may appeal a score under “20” to an ad-hoc committee of no less than three of the following faculty members in the Department of Kinesiology that does NOT include the original screener: Bowers, Carr, Martin, Peak, Reisman, Sadler, Simpson, Tallach. The student shall make written request to the Department Head within two (2) working days of the failed screening. The Department Head will select the ad hoc committee members and appoint a chairperson. The ad hoc committee will determine the time and location of the meeting making reasonable effort to accommodate the student’s schedule and to complete the process within five (5) working days of the appeals request. Each member of the ad hoc committee will rate the student using the same screening instrument. If the three-score average is above “20”, the student’s application will be endorsed by the Department Head. If the three-score average is below “20”, the student’s application will not be endorsed. This decision will be final for the specific application period.
