Rationale for Inclusion in this Category:

**MUSI 1311: Music Theory I** emphasizes Critical Thinking, Communication, Teamwork, and Social Responsibility.

This course provides students with the theoretical knowledge to understand music and helps them to appreciate the musical experience more fully than can be attained by simply listening to them. Students will be able to articulate elements of music theory and expression of the musical arts relative to different cultures and genres and to gain historical perspective. Course activities include group work in which students analyze and critique musical compositions, gaining knowledge to become educated consumers of music, and to make discriminating choices.
