The program is being developed under the Department of Health and Rehabilitation Sciences in the College of Health Sciences. The Tarleton State University DPT Program's rigorous curriculum will be fully aligned with the Commission on Accreditation of Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE) standards. CAPTE is nationally recognized as an accrediting agency by the US Department of Education (USDE) and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) and grants specialized accreditation status to qualified entry-level physical therapy education programs. The proposed 3- year (9-semester) 114-credit Doctor of Physical	P369	202508

		Therapy (DPT) program will provide physical therapist education to prepare entry-level practitioners to provide physical therapist services to patients or clients who have mechanical, physiological and developmental impairments, functional limitations, and disabilities or other health and movement-related conditions in order to determine a diagnosis, prognosis, intervention plan designed to improve quality of life through movement. The developing curriculum is tracked and students enroll as a cohort. The curriculum is a combination of basic science, clinical science, and behavioral science courses with integrated and terminal clinical education experiences. Students will be advised by the DPT Program faculty who are licensed physical therapists. The curriculum, in alignment with both the University and the College Mission, includes opportunities for inter-professional education emphasizing the collaboration needed for high-impact care in rural environments including partnerships with physician assistants, athletic trainers, occupational therapists, nurses, nutrition, speech therapists, social workers, counselors, and teacher's programs also offered through Tarleton State University.
