To demonstrate the ability to provide room and meals for a student applying to Tarleton State University, follow these steps:

1. Complete the U.S. Provider's Living Expenses Affidavit.
2. Attach a copy of the lease, mortgage statement, or deed to the property where the student will be housed. The lease, mortgage statement, or deed must be in the U.S. Provider's name. The lease must be valid **at least until the end of the student's first semester**. In other words, a fall admit must submit a lease that is valid at least until December and a spring admit at least until May of their admission year. An expiring lease will **not** be accepted.
3. Submit both documents to internationalstudents@tarleton.edu.

If approved, this U.S. Provider's Living Expenses Affidavit will substitute for showing evidence of the amount of funding required for the student's living expenses (i.e., room and board).
