### Organizational History

In 1925 Dr. James (J.C.) Terrell opened a medical practice in Stephenville, Texas. A year later an eleven-room hospital and clinic was constructed. Dr. Terrell was joined in 1932 by his brother Dr. Vance Terrell.

A two-story addition was constructed in 1935, and the name was changed to Stephenville Hospital and Clinic. In 1978 a new clinic was built on River North Boulevard. The clinic is now known as the Stephenville Medical and Surgical Center.
