Biographical Note

Mary Anne Foreman was the senior communication specialist for Tarleton State University and a wedding photographer. She served Tarleton for over 23 years. She was a charter member of Delta Zeta Sorority, a member of Kappa Tau Alpha Honorary Journalism Society, and a member of the Bluff Dale United Methodist Church. Foreman was born in Stephenville, Texas on November 10, 1951 to Canty and Mary Kathryn Petty Yarbrough. She married Kenneth Foreman on August 20, 1983. She died on June 21, 2006 and was buried in Wesley Chapel Cemetery, Bluff Dale, Erath County, Texas.

The Mary Anne Foreman Memorial Scholarship was established at Tarleton State University. It provides funding for a full-time student majoring in communications and journalism.
