Biographical Note

Robert J. "Bob" Glasgow was born in 1942 in Stephenville, Texas. He graduated from Stephenville High School, Stephenville, Texas. Afterwards, he served three years (1960-1963) in the United States Army. In 1965, Glasgow married Deanna Carr and they had three children. He received a B.A. from Tarleton State College, Stephenville, Texas, in 1967 where he served as class president and student body president. Afterward, he received a J.D. from the University of Texas at Austin in 1970. Glasgow then started his own law firm in 1970 in Stephenville, Texas. In 1987, Glasgow was named a Distinguished Alumnus at Tarleton State University.

Glasgow served as the administrative assistant to Texas Governor Preston Smith (1969-1970). For eight years (1972-1980), he was the District Attorney for the 29th Judicial District, which served Erath, Hood, and Palo Pinto counties. Glasgow was then elected as one of the 31 members of the Texas Senate, serving the 22nd District of Texas from 1981 to 1993 (67th – 72nd Legislature) as a Democrat.

During his legislative appointment, Glasgow served on the following committees: Jurisprudent (Vice Chair); Redistricting, Committee of the Whole, Special Subcommittee on Legislative Districts (Chair); Finance (Vice Chair); Legislative Redistricting, Select (Chair); Economic Development; Jurisprudence Subcommittee on Criminal Matters (Vice Chair). Glasgow was Governor for a Day during a statewide ceremony at the State Capitol in Austin, Texas, on May 11, 1991. He was also named President Pro Tem of the Senate in 1991.

Glasgow has been a member of the Stephenville Chamber of Commerce since December 1979. He is a 25+ year member of the Tarleton Texan Club. Bob Glasgow continues to serve Erath and its surrounding counties through his law firm and local affiliations.

Scope and Contents

The Bob Glasgow Political Papers consist of bound copies of Texas legislative bills and other Senate documents, press clippings and releases, and research findings on legislative redistricting.

The Legislation series consists of bound copies of Texas legislative bills from 1981 to 1992 and original copies of those bills. Each year of legislation is broken down into a subseries beginning with the 67th Texas legislature and ending with the 72nd Texas legislature. Subseries G consists of original copies of bills that were studied by Glasgow; these bills have handwritten notes by Glasgow.

The Press Clippings and Releases series consists of bound copies of press clippings and press releases from Bob Glasgow's time served in the Texas Senate (1981- 1992).

The Committees series consists of bound copies of committee and subcommittee minutes, agendas, bills, and reports from committees that Glasgow served on during his tenure in the Texas Senate (1981-1992). This series contains materials from the following committees and subcommittees: Texas Senate Jurisprudence Committee 71st Legislature, Joint Select Committee on Worker's Compensation, Texas Senate Judicial Selection/Redistricting 71st Legislature, Texas Senate Select Committee on Tax Equality, Subcommittee on Tax Policy 70th Legislature, Texas Senate Jurisprudence Committee Subcommittee on Criminal Matters, and the Texas Senate Rules Committee 1987-1990.

The Redistricting series consists of folders containing notes, reports, and findings on Legislative redistricting in Texas during Glasgow's time as the Legislative Redistricting Committee Chairman. The folders were originally housed in binders. The 72nd Legislature was involved in redistricting the boundaries for the Texas House of Representatives and Senate, the U.S. Congress, the State Board of Education, and the state's judicial districts. The basic purpose of decennial redistricting is to equalize population in state and congressional districts after publication of the federal census indicates an increase, decrease, or shift in population location.
