**Abstract:** This collection represents research done in 2015 on Stephenville Texas and was a project of Dr. T. Lindsay Baker's History 4350/5309, Spring 2015 class. Included are the Stephenville Historic Resources Inventory compiled by the students, photocopies of photographs, maps, individual files for each structure in the inventory, and electronic files containing photographs.

### Biographical Note

In 1947 Thomas Lindsay Baker was born to Garnell A. and Mary Lois (Miller) Baker. He attended Texas Technology University in the 1960s and 1970s where he earned a Bachelor degree, a Master of Arts, and a Doctorate of Philosophy. He is a former Fulbright Lecturer in Europe.

The museums where Baker has worked include Panhandle-Plains History Museum in Canyon, Texas; Fort Worth Museum of Science and History in Fort Worth, Texas; Texas Heritage Museum of military history at Hill College in Hillsboro, Texas; and the W.K. Gordon Center for Industrial History of Texas in Mingus, Texas. In 1999 he received the Glenda Morgan Award for Museum Excellence.

Baker has written twenty books on Texas and the American West and is the most published author at the Texas A&M Press. He won the Coral H. Tullis Award (Texas State Historical Association) and the Kate Brooks Bates Award (Daughters of the Republic of Texas) in 1980 for *The First Polish Americans*.

Baker was a full professor of history at Tarleton State University where he held the W.K. Gordon Chair from 2002 until his retirement in May 2017. In the spring semester of 2015, he taught the combined course History 4350 (Special Topics in History)/5309 (Historic Preservation). Using guidelines and documentation materials from the Texas Historical Commission, his students conducted an inventory of historical buildings in a selected area of downtown Stephenville, Texas.

## Scope and Contents

This collection represents research done in 2015 on Stephenville, Texas and was a project of Dr. T. Lindsay Baker's History 4350 (Special Topics in History)/5309 (Historic Preservation), Spring 2015 class. The records are organized into two series – (I) Survey forms and field notes and (II) Project files.

Survey forms and field notes include folders for over 147 sites in Stephenville. Each folder contains a typed Texas Historical Commission (THC) Historic Resources Survey Form for an individual site as well as handwritten notes and photocopies of sections of Sanborn maps. Some folders also contain Erath County Appraisal District forms, photocopies of photographs, and other resources. Originals for the photograph photocopies may be found in Stephenville Historical House Museum, Stephenville, Texas or the Dick Smith Library, Tarleton State University. Some of the photographs may also be reproduced in digital format in the Cross Timbers Historical Images Project at <https://www.tarleton.edu/library/crosstimbers/>. One item of interest found in Site 1 folder in this series is the May 1982, bound submittal "A preservation, renovation, and modernization study for: Erath County Courthouse, Stephenville, Texas" by Phillips Swager Associates from Dallas, Texas.

Materials found in the Project files series include binders, correspondence, photograph logs, color and black and white Sanborn maps of Erath County, Texas (1885, 1891, 1896, 1902, 1907, 1912, 1921, 1930, 1949), electronic files, and other resources. Materials have been removed from the binders and placed in folders. Please consult the Container List below for location of those materials.

The electronic files consists of a CD and two flash drives. The CD is titled Texas Historical Commission Historic Resources Survey Packet, December 2014 and contains documents, images, the THC Historic Resources Survey Manual, forms, and other tools. One flash drive is labeled "Stephenville Historic Resources" and the other is "Stephenville Field Photos."

The Project files series also contains three published resources: a photocopy of the Stephenville 1940 city directory, "*Mine Eyes Have Seen: Stephenville Centennial and Fall Fair, 1954*" by the Stephenville Centennial and Fair Committee, and *Images of America: Stephenville* by Ricky L. Sherrod.

Based upon this project, the Texas Historical Commission proposed a historic district in downtown Stephenville, nominated for the National Register of Historic Places. The boundaries of the proposed district were revised slightly to include additional resources. Resource numbers assigned during the student survey are retained. Students surveyed several resources, including houses, not included in the Stephenville Downtown Historic District, so the numbers used in the nomination are not always sequential.
