Abstract: The collection documents the students who attended John Tarleton Agricultural College (now known as Tarleton State University) in Stephenville, Texas from 1917 to 1945. The collection consists of five lists of students' names.

Organizational History

Tarleton State University was established in Stephenville, Texas on September 4, 1899. Through the years it has been known by several names: John Tarleton College, John Tarleton Agricultural College, Tarleton State College, and Tarleton State University. The institution joined the Texas A&M University System in 1917. It is a four year college with almost 100 undergraduate and graduate degrees. The Fall 2019 academic enrollment was over 13,000.

Scope and Contents

The collection documents the students who attended John Tarleton Agricultural College (now known as Tarleton State University) in Stephenville, Texas from 1917 to 1945. The collection consists of five lists of students' names. Four of the lists are arranged by cities with Stephenville not included, by counties, alphabetically by last name with Stephenville included, and alphabetically by last name with Stephenville not included. Out of state students' names are included in each list. The fifth list includes the names of military personnel who attended the Army Specialized Training Program from August 9, 1943 to March 15, 1944. Most of the lists include the student's name, years they attended Tarleton, and home address. When the collection was received, the materials were contained in four binders. The materials were removed from the binders for preservation purposes.
