#### Borrowing materials -

Your Texan card serves as your library card. Remember to bring it with you so you can check out library items. You can have up to 20 items checked out at any time. To contact the circulation staff, email mylibrary@tarleton.edu or call 254-968-9450.

# <u>C</u> Canvas –

#### Class supplies -

The library has a campus bookstore supplies vending machine so you can purchase scantrons, blue books, flash drives, highlighters, pencils, pens, etc. The machine accepts cash. Item costs vary.

#### Computers & Laptops –

Computers are available in the library for your use. You must have a valid NTNET (Tarleton network) username and password to log on to the computers and the campus network.

Wireless laptops can be checked out for up to 4 hours of in-library use. They're equipped with a variety of software packages.

#### Course reserves -

Some instructors put materials like outside readings and sample tests on reserve in the Stephenville campus library or online.

Online course reserves require an instructor-provided username and password. Other course reserves are located at the library's circulation desk and can be checked out with your Texan card.

The library offers photocopiers, printers, and scanners for your use. Copiers take cash or Texan bucks (\$.05/page).

Printing is \$.05 per single-sided and \$.08 per double-sided page. Color printing in the library is \$0.15 per single-sided and \$0.18 per double-sided page. Each semester you get \$5.00 free printing via your Texan card. You can add funds online, at kiosks, or at the Texan Card office.
