### **Organizational History**

Tarleton State University was established in Stephenville, Texas on September 4, 1899. Through the years it has been known by several names: John Tarleton College, John Tarleton Agricultural College, Tarleton State College, and Tarleton State University. The institution joined the Texas A&M University System in 1917. It is a four-year university with almost 100 undergraduate and graduate degrees.

### **Scope and Contents**

The records document the activities of the Teacher Education Program of the College of Education at Tarleton State University from 1987 through 1997. Some of the significant topics represented in these files are program requirements, renovation of the education building, and the E.L. Howell Building dedication. Materials are largely textual comprising soft-cover books and a scrapbook. The scrapbook documents the activities of the Texas Student Education Association (TSEA) by providing photographs of conferences, TSEA meetings, and special events. Some correspondence is included in the scrapbook. Other formats included is a VHS tape. Because the cover of the scrapbook is made of particle board and leather, the pages were removed and re-housed in a separate box.
