Generic BSN APPLICATION FORM

Students applying in fall 2019 for acceptance into pre-nursing in spring 2020 and for students applying in spring 2020 for acceptance into pre-nursing in fall 2020, this criteria applies.

Students applying in fall 2020 for acceptance into pre-nursing beginning spring 2021 and all subsequent semesters, other admission criteria applies (see other form).

Instructions

A point system is used to select students for admission to the generic BSN (Pre Licensure) nursing program at Tarleton State University (TSU). Students who submit all application materials, HESI scores, and meet admission requirements by the deadline will be ranked on a list in descending order according to their total number of points. Available spaces will be filled from the point list until classes are full. Admission is highly competitive and not guaranteed. Students not admitted must submit a new application to be considered for the next admission cycle.

Application to the nursing program is separate from and in addition to the application to Tarleton. To be considered for the program admission the individual **MUST** meet all admission requirements and submit all application materials on or before the **deadline listed below.**

The nursing program application must be submitted by March 15th for fall & October 15th for spring. Applications submitted after the deadline(s) will not be considered.

Admission Requirements

1. GPA of ≥ 3.0 on specific completed English and Science program prerequisite courses (ENGL 1301 and 1302, CHEM 1407 or 1411, BIOL 2401, 2402, and 2420 or 2421).
2. *Composite score ≥ 80 on the HESI A2 (English -Vocabulary, Reading, Grammar), Math, and A&P AND completion of Critical Thinking and Learning Styles) or have ≥ 1180 on the SAT or ≥ 24 on the ACT.

Any test scores must have been taken in 5 years or less.

3. Achieve a minimum of 100 selection points before the residency points are added.
4. Ability to complete all program prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C prior to the program enrollment.
5. Eligibility for RN licensure upon graduation. You must receive criminal background clearance by the Texas Board of Nursing and answer no to eligibility questions or receive a Declaratory Order before acceptance (see part IV of the application for more details).

Please note that meeting admission requirements does not constitute guaranteed admission. Residency points are added after subtotal points are ranked in descending order. Students with the highest points and on-time submission of application will be accepted until the available admission slots are filled. Admission to the nursing program is highly competitive and admission is not guaranteed. The point calculation worksheet is located at www.tarleton.edu/nursing.

Applications for the Spring term will be available starting August 15th and closes October 16th.

Applications for the Fall term will be available starting January 15th and closes March 16th.

a. Items that will be uploaded during the application process; within the application link include the Tarleton State University letter of acceptance, hand written narrative and application fee receipt. Have all items ready when you fill out your application.

- i. You must submit receipt of the \$35 non-refundable application fee payment within the application link; during the application process. Payments are to be made through the Tarleton Marketplace center at the following link:

- ii. Narrative must be handwritten. Please see requirements below.

3. Submit HESI scores (please review HESI requirements in admission requirements above). Only HESI scores that are submitted from an authorized testing center will be accepted.

 1. Academic performance and aptitude.
 2. Ability to perform capably in positions of responsibility.
 3. Potential to achieve the objectives of this program of study and/or your interest in the nursing profession.

Provide a stamped and addressed envelope to each person selected. **The envelope should be sealed by the evaluator with their signature across the seal.**

NOTE: The School of Nursing Undergraduate Program Committee (UPC) considers the quality of your reference selections when evaluating your admission status as well as the content of the reference. For example, personal friends or relatives should not be asked to complete a reference for you.

5. Unofficial or copies of official Transcripts from Every College and/or University attended regardless of the number of credit(s) earned or whether or not the courses are part of the required course work for the nursing degree (not required to submit if Tarleton has transcripts).

- a. You may send the unofficial transcripts and copies to generic_nursing@tarleton.edu. Tarleton must still have received all official transcripts.

6. If an LVN and applying for the generic BSN program in Stephenville, please email your LVN license confirmation to generic_nursing@tarleton.edu.

5. Include any additional information that you want the SAMAS Committee to consider.

Members of the School of Nursing SAMAS Committee will evaluate your narrative on content and quality using the following rating scale. Evaluation of quality will be based on spelling, punctuation, legibility of handwriting, grammar, and congruency of written dialogue with prompts 1-5.

Rating Scale: 4=Outstanding; 3=Good; 2=Fair; 1=Poor; 0=No Evidence

Part IV - Eligibility Requirements for Licensure as a Registered Nurse

Criminal Background Evaluation: Upon tentative acceptance to the program you will be required to undergo a criminal history record check. The record check process includes: (1) the school submitting your name to the Texas Board of Nursing, (2) you completing the form provided by the school necessary to schedule a fingerprint appointment with an authorized service center; (3) electronic submission of your scanned fingerprints from the service center to the TX DPS/FBI; and (4) results of the record check delivered to the TX Board of Nursing from the TX DPS/FBI. Other required background checks you will complete include the OIG (Office of Inspector General) for HealthCare exclusions. The Board will send you a result card that identifies either that your record is clear or you need a Declaratory Order. You are required to submit this card to your clinical compliance document management system to receive final program acceptance. If a Declaratory Order is needed you will not receive final acceptance until we receive a copy of order that you receive from the Board.

Eligibility for Licensure: The Texas Board of Nursing has identified certain circumstances that may render a potential candidate ineligible for licensure as a registered nurse in the State of Texas. Eligibility for licensure upon graduation is one of the admission requirements for Tarleton's nursing program. If you must answer "YES" to any of the following questions or your result card from the Board does not show a clear criminal history record check, you must submit a copy of your Declaratory Order, or other appropriate ruling, from the Texas Board of Nursing to the nursing office before you can be considered for admission. Non-disclosure of relevant information raises questions related to truthfulness and character.

Declaratory Order Process

If you answered "YES" to any of the questions listed in this section, contact the nursing program's office at generic_bsn@tarleton.edu and the Board's Education/Examination at https://www.bon.texas.gov/forms_declaratory_order.asp for a Declaratory Order Petition. The Board has the authority to make a decision regarding an individual's eligibility to take the licensing examination and licensure as a registered nurse. Processing your Petition may take 6 to 9 months or longer, depending on the circumstances. Once all requested documents have been received, the Petition will be submitted to the Board's Legal Department for review. You will be notified by the Board of Nursing when the review is complete.
