

Limited Acceptance Review and Selection Process

Funding agencies and sponsors sometimes limit the number of grant awards extended to an institution when multiple proposals have been submitted. If the funding agency sends a notice of award for more than the number allowed in the grant terms and conditions and offers Tarleton the opportunity to select which award(s) the institution would accept, the following process will be followed.

Selection Process

An ad hoc committee will be appointed by the AVP for Research to review the submitted proposals using the following evaluative criteria. Award(s) for the project proposal(s) with the highest score(s) will be accepted by the institution for implementation.

- Degree of alignment of the project proposal to the strategic plans of the department, college, and/or university
- Broader impacts of proposal
- Consideration of prior grant work and/or internal grant performance (if applicable)
- Amount of indirect cost generated

Notification

The committee process will be subject to the sponsor's timeline and conducted accordingly. The ORI will notify investigators and relevant stakeholders of the committee's decision via email within the timeline specified by the sponsor.
