

Withdraw Refund Schedule

Tuition adjusted based on the date of withdrawal- students are responsible for any remaining balance

Withdrawing from: Session Length - 10 weeks or greater	% of refund
Prior to first class day	100% <i>(student owes 0%)</i>
During first five class days	80% <i>(student owes 20%)</i>
During second five class days	70% <i>(student owes 30%)</i>
During third five class days	50% <i>(student owes 50%)</i>
During fourth five class days	25% <i>(student owes 75%)</i>
After fourth five class days	0% <i>(student owes 100%)</i>

Withdrawing from:

Session Length - Greater than 5 weeks and Less than 10 weeks	% of refund
Prior to first class day	100% <i>(student owes 0%)</i>
During first, second or third class day	80% <i>(student owes 20%)</i>
During fourth, fifth or sixth class day	50% <i>(student owes 50%)</i>
After sixth class day	0% <i>(student owes 100%)</i>

Withdrawing from: Session Length 5 Weeks or Less	% of refund
Prior to first class day	100% <i>(student owes 0%)</i>
During first class day	80% <i>(student owes 20%)</i>
During second class day	50% <i>(student owes 50%)</i>
After second class day	0% <i>(student owes 100%)</i>

Withdrawing from ALL Courses at the University

Effective Withdrawal Date is the date the withdrawal is reported and recorded in the Registrar's Office.

Note: For refund purposes, class days are determined by the calendar, not by the number of class meetings. As an example, if a semester starts on Monday, Thursday of that week is considered the 4th class day for all classes.
