I. Overview

The Tarleton State University Information Security Controls Catalog establishes the minimum standards and controls for University information security in accordance with the state's Information Security Standards for Institutions of Higher Education found in Title 1, Chapter 202, Texas Administrative Code (TAC 202).

II. Purpose

To develop, document, and disseminate a media protection policy that addresses purpose, scope, roles, responsibilities, management commitment, coordination among University entities, and compliance; and includes procedures to facilitate the implementation of the media protection policy and associated media protection controls; and review and updates the current media protection policy and related procedures.

III. Scope

The scope of these regulations and procedures are applicable to all information resources owned or operated by Tarleton State University. All users are responsible for adhering to this policy. If needed or appropriate, information regarding roles, responsibilities, management commitment, and coordination among organizational entities are embedded within these procedures.

IV. Risk Statement

Media (e.g., documents, computer media (e.g. tapes, disks), input/output data, and system documentation) is compromised by unauthorized parties due to ineffective handling procedures.



V. Regulations and Procedures

The State of Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) has chosen to adopt a select number of Media Protection Controls as established within the NIST SP 800-53 control family guidelines identified by the DIR Security Control Standards Catalog. Tarleton is responsible for policy and procedures that address media protection controls.
