**I. Statement**

The Tarleton I.T.S. security office and system administrators will monitor appropriate sources to receive security alerts from system manufactures.

**II. Applicability**

This Control applies to all Tarleton network information resources. The intended audience for this Control includes all information resource owners, custodians, and users of information resources.

**III. Risk Statement**

Contacts with special interest groups or other specialist, security forums, and professional associations is not coordinated or performed as a result of ill-defined processes.

**IV. Implementation**

The University receives information security advisories from the Texas A&M University System ("TAMUS") Security Operations Center, Texas Department of Information Resources (TxDIR), Multistate Information Sharing and Analysis Center (MS-ISAC), and United States Computer Emergency Response Team (US-CERT). The chief information security officer issues security directives to information resources owners, custodians and users when intelligence indicates an information security alert or advisory may have a negative impact on university information resource operations.
