The Master of Arts in English with TMATE certification is designed to expand and enrich a student's knowledge of language and literature, to encourage critical thinking, and to develop research, writing, analytical abilities in literary and rhetorical studies. This degree will prepare students to pursue a PhD in the discipline, and enhance knowledge and research skills for teaching in public education.

Your Future

The TMATE program is a year-long graduate program for highly motivated people with a bachelor's degree who want to become certified school teachers. Pursuing a MA in English will enable one to teach dual credit courses as well as teach at the community college level.

The Program

The 36 or 39 hour MA in English includes a combination of face-to-face, online and hybrid coursework. Twelve hours of one foreign language at the undergraduate level are required. Additional leveling courses may be required. If the student takes ENGL 5380 or ENGL 5398 during TMATE, the course can replace EDUC 5315. Work closely with Dr. Estes, TMATE Director, if you are planning to pursue this degree option.
