The Master of Arts in History with TMATE certification is designed to expand and enrich a student's knowledge of history, to encourage critical thinking about the world, and to develop research, writing, analytical abilities in United States, European, and World History. This degree will prepare students to pursue a PhD in the discipline, and enhance knowledge and research skills for teaching in public education.

Your Future

The TMATE program is a year-long graduate program for highly motivated people with a bachelor's degree who want to become certified school teachers. Pursuing a MA in History will enable one to teach dual credit courses as well as teach at the community college level.

The Program

The 39-42 hour MA in History includes a combination of face-to-face, online and hybrid coursework. Additional leveling courses may be required.
