- No grade lower than a "C" in BIOL 1406, BIOL 1407, MATH 2412, and WSES 2405.

- Completion of Experiential Learning is required before taking WSES 4187

### **Degree Information**

- Individual academic programs may require specific courses contained in parts of University Core Curriculum as prerequisites for certain major requirements. Stuc wish to take courses that will fulfill both core and major requirements simultaneously should be check with academic advisors for assistance in selecting core courses.
- Students meet the Writing Proficiency Requirement by completing two upper-level Writin Intensive courses in their major or courses designed for their degree program. Contact the Academic Advisor for additional information or questions.
- Residence is satisfied only by official enrollment in and completion of course work applied the degree requirements.

A minimum of 30 semester hours of work counted toward the degree must be compl Tarleton. The work completed at Tarleton and counted toward the degree must inclu least 30 advanced hours (3000 or 4000 level) and 12 of these advanced hours must major subject.

- A minimum of 45 advanced credits (3000/4000 level course work) are required and need satisfy degree requirements.
- How does duplicating a course impact my GPA?

A student may take a course a second or subsequent time at the same institution. T highest grade will be included in the GPA calculation.

• Can I take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU?

If you plan to take a course at another school and transfer it back to TSU, you need with both an advisor and Transfer Services. An advisor can tell you the correct cours to take and assist with completion of a Concurrent Enrollment Form if needed.
